



Impact Statement

2016: The Foundation was active in 2016 supporting churches and community service agencies in the Los Angeles area to provide educational supplies.

- Greater Zion Church in Compton, CA on 8/14/16: Donation of 165 backpacks filled with school supplies as well as a laptop computer to a high school graduate attending her 1st year in college.
